## **Health Alert Network**

Central District Health Department (CDHD) participates in the Health Alert Network (HAN)- a nationwide system for coordinating and distributing important information about public health events.

There are three message categories:

- Health Alert- highest level of importance, requires immediate action or attention.
- Health Advisory- provides important information for a specific incident or situation; may not require immediate action.
- Health Update- offers updated information regarding an incident or situation; unlikely to require immediate action.

HAN messages pertaining to our service area are distributed by CDHD via a variety of messaging means (social media, fax, news stations, and newspaper) depending on the audience whether it be the media, pharmacists, hospitals, or the public. ### **Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month**

March is Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month! Colorectal Cancer is the 2<sup>nd</sup> leading cause of cancer deaths.

With screening, the process of detecting cancer or precancerous growths in the colon or rectum, colorectal cancer is one of the most preventable of all cancers. Screening is recommended for men and women ages 50-74, or earlier if there is a family history of colon related cancer.

One of the most effective preventative screening tools is the Fecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT). If you are age 50 or older, or younger if you have history of colon and/or rectum cancer in your family, CDHD can provide you with a **FREE FOBT kit**!
